After I come home this morning
I painted the top of "Henry" so the next
time I go for a ride in a rain storm
I won't get wet. Probably you think
I am all wet anyway, but maybe you
will be in "Henry" some day when it is
raining.

I drove to Pine Canyon yesterday
and saw the folks, everyone seemed
to be happy out there. She claimed to
be lonesome because Doris and Ted are the
only ones home now. She is well pleased
with the horse coat you made, it fits perfect
Dad and Albert is laying the tree up

for the walls of the house after work.
It will soon be up to the square or where
the roof starts.

Since I came down from Toyan
the weather has dropped down to
the freezing point or near there because
crystals of ice begin to form on a bucket
of water sitting near the sled last night.

I will be able to pay you a little of what
