longer an idle dreamer because I am
able to divert my thinking on the job

I am doing. I find or at least I feel better when I am able to finish one or two lessons in a day. While at home I sat down to study and get a page or two read then someone come in with something for me to do, by the time I got that done I forgot what I read because I quit in the middle of a thought. ●

You have a wonderful schedule for a birthday. There is no one who could arrange things to suite the ~~circumstances~~ circumstances any better than you can. I know with the arrangement that we won't get into any ~~much~~ mischief.

Yesterday I went to Sunday School in Lake Point then drove to Pine Canyon to see my folks. They were all O.K. and

went to see "Brigham Young" in the afternoon. I should have gone but I hadn't been to sleep for 24 hours and had only slept six hours in the past 36 so I came home and went to bed.

It was 3:30 P.M. when I hit this welcoming old bed and didn't know a thing until 9:30 A.M. this morning when the milk boy hammered on the door for the milk money.

Well, even if I don't let you know by a letter that I remember you, you can be sure that I remember you in my prayers. I know that God will let a rich portion of his Holy Spirit be with you because you always try to do his will and keep his commandments.
