I like winter weather in Logan  
& everything that goes with it; out here  
there is so much salt in the ground  
that the water won't freeze on the  
plate to make a skating rink, that  
is another reason that I miss Logan

Yesterday I got so lonesome  
when I sat in the shack that I  
went outside & cut a fire into  
kindling wood with a handax,  
about 3:30 I came in out of the  
weather and ate dinner, ~~the~~  
of roast pork potatoes and some

Kind of gross, but it ~~is~~ was  
nothing nearly as good as you  
could fix even when you are in  
a hurry. Cook is O.S. for one or  
two meals but for all times it  
gets tiresome.

They are building lots of  
new buildings out here, they are  
ones like those at the Salt  
Lake Airport. Up until today they  
had me shoveling or pushing a  
wheelbarrow but this afternoon  
I helped the carpenters build forms  
for the foundation of the Store house.

Yes, I get the mail out here  
but don't try to send anything but  
a letter, because Wallin has a bigger  
appetite than I and you know  
how much I eat when I lay a  
pound which is only a sample

of that consumed when I was  
working hard.

Thanks dear for sending me  
a reminder, I will try to keep  
your post man busier than he has  
been for the last six months.

God Bless us as he has in the  
Past.
