Marvin & I decided it was best to drive "Henry" to Logan Saturday. because it would save \$2.50 or \$3.00 for someone & a penny saved is a penny earned, so we will all see you around 2:00 P.M. Saturday for a few hours before we depart for the Mission Field.

They gave us some good doops on lots of important principals of the Gospel that is good for a missionary to know. The first & most important thing for a young missionary to learn is to Pray. A prayer is separated into two parts Thanks and request.

We have heard seven ^{hour} lectures a day since we have been here. Every one has some special message for us, for example there is an hour a day which is designed to acquaint us with the Bible, & an hour a day to acquaint us with the Book of Mormon. We are assigned a good lesson from each class to be worked up for the following day. A representative from the ~~Miss~~ various heads of the church addresses us on the subject of their particular department to the missionary.

A few of the rules they gave special stress on ~~was~~ ^{were}: no visiting of opposite sex, no dancing, no swimming, keep Word of Wisdom, and in all respects act like a gentleman. A few months ago dancing would have been hard for me to give up but since we were in Wendover it will be an easy task.
