After laboring fairly steady the first  
5 days - meeting and explaining the  
Gospel to the folks of roundup

we received a letter in the morning  
mail from our District Pres. He  
notifies us of a change in the Personnel.  
Companion & I who has labored together  
5 months will be separated. He will  
stay in Roundup & have one of the 2  
Elders who are on their way to Mont.  
I will go to Billings & work with the  
other new Elder according to word  
received.

From now on till you hear

Billings, Mont.) If you have sent any  
mail to this old address you needn't



woray because Elder Millett & his  
Companion will have the same box as  
we have had. and if any mail  
comes to me he will forward it and  
only a day or so time will be lost.

I have been doing very little  
reading lately. Only to 240 in the  
Articles of Faith this time & it has been  
nearly 2 weeks since starting.

from reading a little now and  
then. One is able to understand things  
better - things that help to make  
a fellow a better sort of guy -

Now there will be a big job  
for me to do I suppose - Especially

if my new companion is anything like I was when I arrived. This fellow sure sees how dumb he was when he first landed in Minnesota. Now I just begin to find how much I don't know. I'll live & learn, sometimes by an ~~and~~ <sup>big</sup> bump, sometimes otherwise.

Well, time to get packing again, everytime I think of packing I have the thought of settling for good some day, but I guess it is all in the life of a missionary to pack & unpack. Every time I discover a new wrinkle from one of my companions.

I have eyes to see with, but they see only you! And my love for you is still growing.
