and mingle with these folks this day.

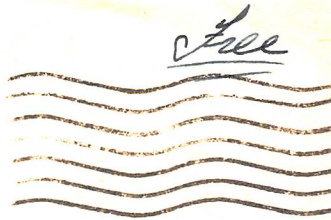
Well Dear Wife and son it's time
