Yps here in this section is a little bit different from down in Nishinomeya. Yps here there is lots of mud and hills or mountains while down in the south we had lots of sand and right on the coast of the Pacific Ocean.

So far no one knows just what the job will be here but this Bn has charge of the Army Communication here in this area of Japan - Radio - Telephone - Telephatyp - Radio grams and maintenance of equipment. Just what each of us will be assigned to is hard to tell. But whatever it is will be something according

To the army version to keep us busy.

I am in the mess hall - Theater -
Red cross canteen, library and all else
That you can think of while I am
writing this letter. There will be a
movie in a few minutes now so
you can see how things are lined
up.

Where ever one goes He knows

Salvation.

family while I have to be over
here and may this fellow be
worthy of your love & duty.
