Greetings Dear Family,

There isn't much on the line this evening. In fact the radio is bringing Kay Kizers School of Musical Knowledge - so this letter will no doubt be mixed up - a little bit perhaps.

These last few days I have been washing up my clothing ^{showing} and cleaning up a wee bit. Mon spent the most part of the day washing a sweater - 7028 Pcs of Sox - 6 Pairs of Garments & woolen underwear Bottom half. Now I wear my Summer weight Garments with a pair of woolen G.I. Drawers over them. The G.I. heavy underwear comes in Two Pieces - the top is just like a sweat shirt - & the bottom made of the same material only on the order of a tight pair of trousers. I have a good heavy wool sweater

that I wear instead of the top half of
the long handled undershirt. It
makes me feel more like I did in
Montana.

Yesterday I folded my clothes
& put them away then took my
work clothing up to a Japanese
laundry. For a half dollar or so
they will wash 4 or 5 uniforms.
Or to bring it closer to what you
know - for one candy bar they
will wash & iron two Green field
Pants. (tailored on the order of the
sun tan suite) - one fatigue pants
and three fatigue jackets & one
fatigue hat - yes. all for one
candy bar & they will give you
enough change to fill a wash tub.
